

## CONTEST RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Eligibility

The contest is only open to legal residents of Alberta who are at least eighteen years of age. Employees of Alberta Environment its advertising agencies, promotion and service agencies, and members of each of their immediate families (spouse, and parents, siblings and children, and each of their spouses, regardless of where they live) and persons living in the households of each of these individuals, whether related or not, are not eligible to participate. Only one entry per person will be accepted.

2. How to Enter

To enter, complete the entry form printed in the Environment Week insert in the Edmonton and Calgary Sun Newspapers. Contest begins on Sunday June 4, 2006 and all entries must be received by 4:30 p.m. Thursday June 15, 2006 at which time contest closes.

**Odds**

The odds of winning a Prize in this contest are dependent upon the total number of eligible entry forms received.

**Prizes:**

A random draw will be conducted of the entry forms received. Decisions made by the designated Alberta Environment draw judge are considered final.

4. Prize Notification

The entrant eligible to receive a prize will be notified by telephone using the phone number written on the entry form. Alberta Environment reserves the right to re-draw a potential winner or withdraw the prize if the potential winner could not be contacted within seventy-two (72) hours of the draw, if the prize is not claimed within seventy-two (72) hours, or if the prize is refused.
